

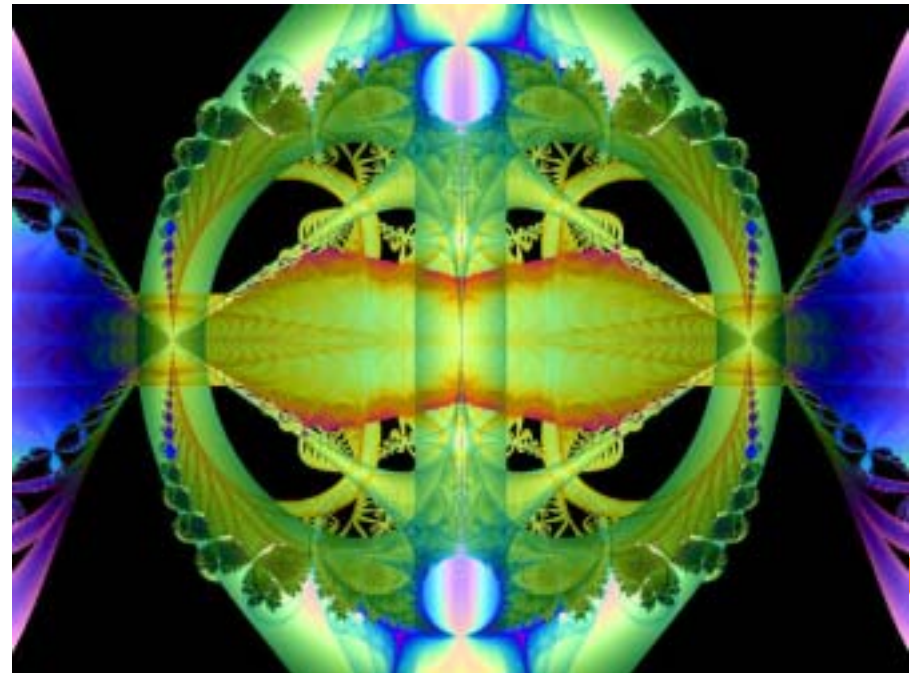

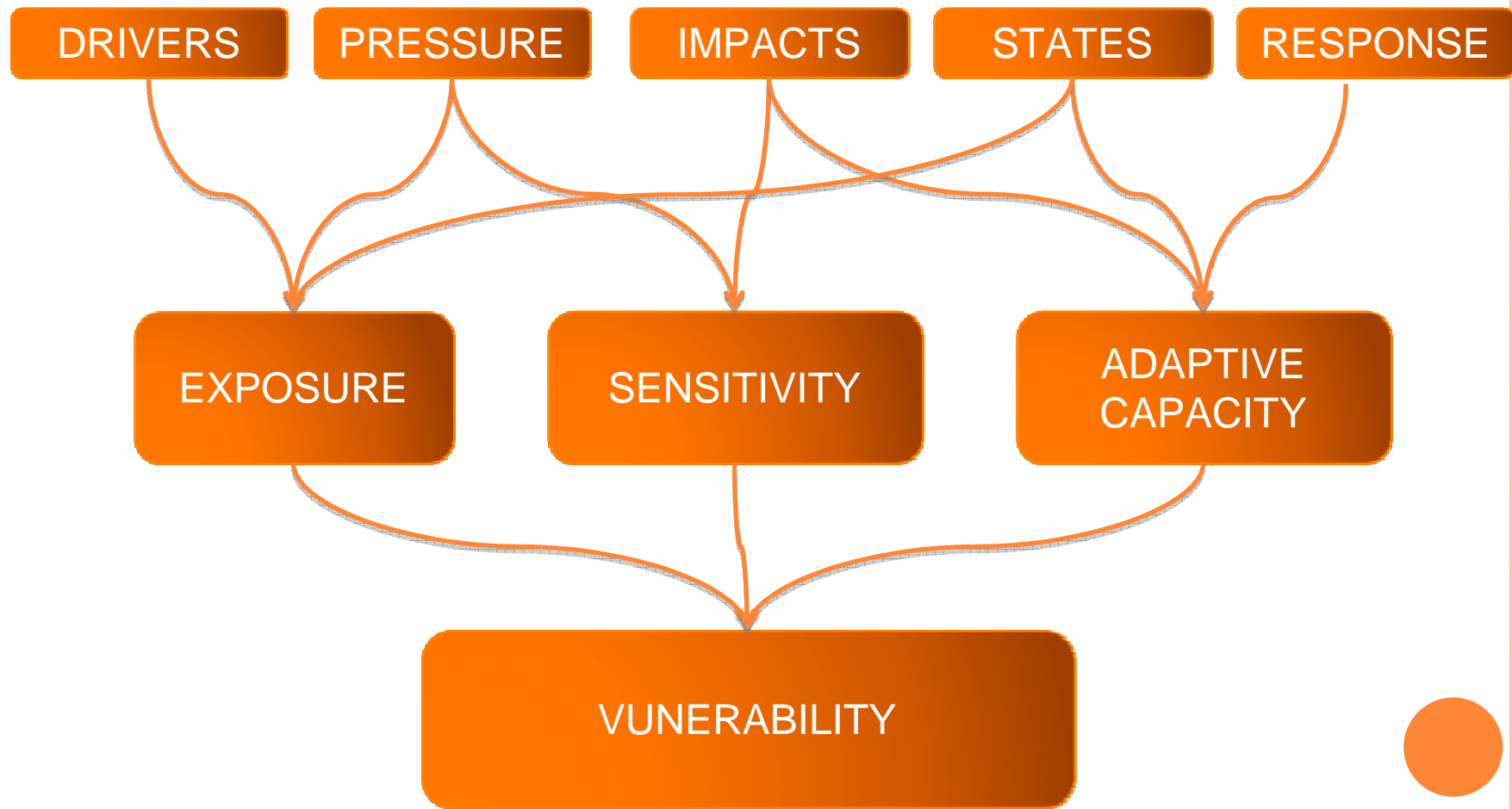


OUR TASK
